Q.1 Answer the following in about 150 words each: 10x5=50

- (a) "The League of Nations was not a complete failure." Justify this statement with examples. [10 Marks]
- (b) "Chinese Revolution left deep mark on the World Politics." Explain. [10 Marks]
- (c) Delineate the Cultivation System in Dutch East Indies during the 19th century. [10 Marks]
- (d) Was Russian Revolution just a Coup or a mass insurrection? Give different interpretations. [10 Marks]
- (e) "Triangular contest of ideology was a major factor in the Second World War." Elaborate. [10 Mark]

Q.2

- (a) "Rousseau's political philosophy contains the seeds of Socialism, Absolutism and Democracy." Comment. [20 Marks]
- (b) "The peace keeping efforts of the UNO has been a baggage of mix success." Examine this statement with examples. [20 Marks]
- (c) Discuss why British colonised South Africa? Also delineate the grant of self-governance. [10 Marks]

Q.3

- (a) "Industrial Revolution in the USA during the Second Industrial Revolution Era (1870-1916) marked a shift from the earlier period." Elaborate. [20 Marks]
- (b) "The first episode in the saga of German unification under Bismarck came with the Schleswig-Holstein Question." Elucidate. [20 Marks]
- (c) What role did appeasement play in the international affairs during 1930s? Substantiate with examples. [10 Marks]

Q.4

- (a) "NATO was a logical sequence of the Brussels Treaty and it played key role in the dominance of the USA in Europe." Elucidate. [20 Marks]
- (b) The impact of the first world war was extraordinarily wide-ranging, encompassing all aspects of political, social and economic arena." Elaborate with examples. [20 Marks]
- (c) Delineate the factors contributing for the emergence of a unipolar world after the Cold War. [10 Marks]

- (b) "For Kant, an individual becomes enlightened when he has the courage to think and act without the guidance of another." Comment. [10 Marks]
- (c) Briefly explain the main features of the US Federal Constitution. [10 Marks]
- (d) "Eastern Question was a shifting, intractable and interwoven tangle of conflicting interests of the Powers." Comment. [10 Marks]
- (e) Was Nazism a natural development of German history or it was one-off, a normal development? Discuss giving different views. [10 Marks]

- (a) Critically examine Lenin's New Economic Policy (NEP), his motives behind NEP and its result. [20 Marks]
- (b) Critically analyse the benefits which fascism bring for the Italian people. [20 Marks]
- (c) Discuss the popular character of the French Revolution. [10 Marks]

Q.7

- (a) Discuss the nature and character of Non-alignment movement. [20 Marks]
- (b) Elaborate reasons of rapid industrialisation of Germany after unification and differences with British industrialisation. [20 Marks]
- (c) "If I could save the Union without freeing-any slave, I would do it; and if I could save it by freeing all the slaves, I would do it; and if I could save it by freeing some and leaving others alone, I would also do that." Comment. [10 Marks]

- (a) "Though the Reform Act, 1832 was criticised for many reasons, it was still important not only for what it was but also for what it sets in motion." Explain. [20 Marks]
- (b) "American colonies as children of England, had come of age, and that nothing could have long delayed a political separation." Explain. [20 Marks]
- (c) How far do you agree with the view that Spanish ulcer ruined Napoleon Bonaparte? [10 Marks]
